❄️ Ice Safety Verification Layer

- ☐ Spud bar or ice chisel for checking ice as you move *
- ☐ Ice auger plus depth tape for measured thickness checks *
- ☐ Ice thickness reference card with 4 inch and 12+ inch thresholds *
- ☐ Daily ice recheck checklist for morning and after overnight weather *
- ☐ Ice route marker flags for checked travel and camp zones *
- ☐ Load-spreading sled for shanty, heater and heavy gear *

🔥 Enclosed Heat & Ventilation Layer

- ☐ Indoor-rated shanty heater with stable shutoff base *
- ☐ Battery-powered carbon monoxide detector *
- ☐ Vent gap clips or wedges to keep airflow open *
- ☐ Spare heater fuel stored outside the sleeping area *
- ☐ Small fire extinguisher rated for camp heater use *
- ☐ Heat-safe heater base or platform for the shanty floor *
- ☐ Shanty ventilation reminder card posted near the heater *

🧊 Cold Water Emergency Layer

- ☐ Neck-worn ice picks for self-rescue *
- ☐ Throw rope bag staged outside the shanty *
- ☐ Flotation suit or properly fitted PFD *
- ☐ Sealed dry clothes bag for emergency changeout *
- ☐ Emergency whistle and strobe light *
- ☐ Waterproof phone or radio pouch kept on body *

Ø<B£ Ice Fishing Gear Basics

- ☐ Ice fishing rods and reels *
 - ☐ Ice auger with charged battery or sharp hand blades *
 - ☐ Insulated bait or mealworm container *
 - ☐ Ice tackle box with jigs, hooks and small terminal tackle *
 - ☐ Ice skimmer or scoop for clearing holes *
 - ☐ Fish bucket or compact livewell
 - ☐ Fish ruler, license and local regulation card *
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&ú Camp Basics

- ☐ Insulated ice shanty or shelter rated for overnight use *
 - ☐ Cold-rated sleeping bag matched to overnight lows *
 - ☐ High R-value sleeping pad or cot insulation *
 - ☐ Dry base layers reserved for sleeping *
 - ☐ Vapor barrier socks or boot liners
 - ☐ Headlamp and low-glare shanty lantern *
 - ☐ Cold-weather spare batteries kept warm *
 - ☐ Repair tape, cord and shelter patch kit
 - ☐ Snow shovel and scraper for clearing around the shanty *
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Ø<B£ Camp Kitchen

- ☐ Thermos for hot drinks staged away from the heater *
 - ☐ One-burner stove for cooking outside the sleep area *
 - ☐ Stove fuel kept separate from heater fuel *
 - ☐ Insulated water storage to prevent freezing *
 - ☐ Soup, instant meals and high-calorie snacks *
 - ☐ Cookware, insulated mug and long spoon *
 - ☐ Trash bag for food waste and heater packaging *
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
